

Chlorine Gas & Corrosive gas

Inclusion

Patient indications: suspected chlorine gas inhalation or exposure AND symptoms of respiratory or eye toxicity, including, coughing & choking with SOB, wheezes, rhinorrhea, lacrimation, burning eyes and burning sensation in mucous membranes

Pre-Decon

Remove from source

Decon

Dry and wet skin decontamination, if patient has skin symptoms. Eye decontamination if patient exhibits eye symptoms.

Post-Decon

Adult

- IV, monitor, O2 and airway management

Medication Therapy:

- Administer albuterol 2.5 mg SVN repeat every 5 minutes

Peds <14 y/o

- IV, monitor, O2 and airway management

Medication Therapy:

- Administer albuterol 2.5 mg SVN repeat every 5 minutes
