# **Sulfide Toxicity**

# Inclusion

Patient indications: suspected sulfide exposure and upper airway irritation, laryngospasm, painful dermatitis, pneumonitis, non-cardiogenic pulmonary edema (late onset).

### Pre-Decon

Remove from source

#### Decon

Removing the patient from the source will usually be the only decontamination required.

## Post-Decon

- Initiate IV normal saline fluid bolus
- · Cardiac monitor, supplemental O2, and IV
- Contact medical control before administering treatment

#### **Adult**

Medication Therapy:

- Sodium Nitrite 300 mg IV/IO over 5-10 minutes

(May administer faster during codes)

# Peds <14y/o

Medication Therapy:

- Sodium Nitrite 0.6 mg/kg (0.2 ml/kg) of 300mg/10ml solution IV/IO over 5-10 minutes
- Max dose 10 ml (300 mg)

(May administer faster during codes)
