

# GI COMPLAINT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

## Initiate Immediate Supportive Care:

O2 to maintain sat  $\geq 94\%$   
Complete primary and secondary survey as indicated  
Vital Signs (FSBG and temperature as indicated)  
Cardiac Monitor as indicated  
12-lead ECG as indicated

## Inclusion Criteria:

Abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea



## Initiate IV NS/LR TKO

If normotensive, consider saline lock with NS flush  
*Push all meds slowly*  
If significant volume depletion, administer *NS/LR 20ml/kg* bolus  
Reassess VS and lung sounds after every 500ml infused  
May repeat as needed for continued hypotension

**Hold for patients with Renal Failure or CHF, unless SBP < 90**

## If Nausea or Vomiting:

### *Ondansetron (Zofran)*

- 0.1mg/kg (up to 4mg) SIVP
- If no improvement, may repeat x 1 after 15 minutes

## Abdominal Pain

Consider **Pain Management AO**

## Notification to include:

GI Administrative Order, Chief complaint, unit number, patient age, gender, and ETA to receiving facility.  
Advise if patient is unstable.
