

# SEIZURE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

## Initiate immediate supportive care:

Protect patient from injury  
O2 to maintain sat  $\geq$  94%  
Complete primary and secondary survey as indicated  
Vital Signs (FSBG and temperature as indicated)  
Cardiac Monitor

## Use this Administrative Order on the following patients:

- Seizure activity
- Postictal mental status

## **Do not use this Administrative Order on the following patients:**

- **Pregnant > 20 weeks gestation and no history of seizures (Follow OB AO)**

Actively Seizing

### NO

If patient is NOT actively seizing,  
continue with supportive care

### Yes

If patient actively seizing administer  
**Midazolam (Versed) IM first**

- **Midazolam (Versed) 0.2mg/kg** (max 10 mg) IM
- If IV already established administer **Midazolam (Versed) 0.1mg/kg** (max 5 mg)
- **Initiate IV NS/LR TKO**
  - If normotensive, consider saline lock with NS flush  
*Push all meds slowly*
- If seizure continues for 10 minutes:
  - No IV access: repeat **Midazolam (Versed) 0.2mg/kg** (max 10 mg) IM
  - If IV access: administer **Midazolam (Versed) 0.1mg/kg** (max 5 mg)
- Monitor Airway and breathing

### Special Considerations:

If patient is <6 years old, consider febrile seizure and provide cooling techniques

### Notification to include:

Seizure Administrative Order, unit number, patient age, gender, and ETA to receiving facility.  
Advise if patient is unstable.
